Covid Considerations 2021-2022

A new operating plan for this school year has been drafted in collaboration with the Department of Education and the recommendations from the Chief Medical Officer for the Yukon. It will be shared shortly. I am so very pleased to start this school year with some health measures in place to keep us safe but with many Covid restrictions relaxed to create a more 'normal' classroom environment.

We will require everyone, k-7 and all adults, to wear masks in the common spaces (halls, stairwells, foyer and buses) but within the classroom, masks will not be required. Hand sanitization will continue when entering the building and at the entrance to every classroom. Grades 4-7 will line-up on the front lawn and Grades k-3 will line-up on the soccer field to enter the school but students will be invited to play until the bell.

We will have two recesses this year. Recess I - K, grades 1, 6 & 7 and Recess II, grades 2, 3, 4, & 5. This allows us to keep the numbers to half on the playground but permits students to see and play with same-grade peers during the breaks. Classroom teachers will continue to eat with their classes and supervision will be covered by ancillary staff and administration.

Masks: please send your child with a reusable mask with their name clearly marked on the item. We will provide lanyards to help students stay organized. Masks are required for halls, stairwells and buses. Reusable masks will drastically reduce our environmental

Parking and Buses at ÉWES

A reminder that the 'Drop Off Zone," the lane to the right as you pull into our parking lot from 4th Avenue, is for a "kiss and goodbye hug." You may not leave your vehicle unattended in this lane. If you would like to accompany your child into the school, please use the parking lot, 3d Ave or Black Street to park your car.

No Parking is Permitted in the Drop Off Zone - Fire Vehicles Require Safe Access at all Times.

Buses: Masks are required to ride the bus. Parents are reminded to register students for the buses at <u>https://yukon.ca/en/annual-school-bus-registration</u>. Students will have assigned seats and tags will be required to ride the bus.

We ask that parents please let classroom teachers know of any appointments in advance but come early enough to help get your child ready for the appointment. Come into the office with a mask and we will direct you to the classroom. We appreciate your understanding.

Sick? What do I do?

This year, we will ask that parents and guardians continue to monitor their children for symptoms before sending them to school everyday.

Most common symptoms: fever dry cough tiredness

Less common symptoms: aches and pains sore throat Diarrhea conjunctivitis headache loss of taste or smell a rash on skin, or discolouration of fingers or toes

Serious symptoms: difficulty breathing or shortness of breath chest pain or pressure loss of speech or movement

All students and staff should stay home and arrange for testing if they have symptoms, no matter how mild. To assess symptoms, parents and staff can use the Covid 19 self-assessment tool or contact a health care provider for additional guidance.
